Amendment #2

Page 3, Lines 6-13, amend as follows:

A. Four <u>Ten</u> 75 percent (4 <u>10</u> 75%) of the <u>interest earned annually</u> average market value of the Fund covering the past three fiscal years will be used as supplemental funding for programs and services to benefit veterans, as noted under § 1172 on an annual basis. The market value of the Fund's <u>interest earned</u> at the end of the previous <u>audited fiscal year 12 quarters</u> will be used to determine the average market value of the Fund for <u>allowable</u> expenditure (i.e. budget purposes). The excess of the Fund income over expenditures shall be reinvested in the Fund to cover the rate of inflation and to provide for reasonable Fund growth.

Page 3, Line 20, amend as follows:

C. Of the four ten 75 percent (4 10 75%) of the Fund (Interest Earned Market Value), ninety-five percent


